

ACCESSIBILITY OF ROOMS AT TATTOO CIRCUS 25

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CAFETE

Access

The cafeteria is accessible via a ramp. The entrance door is 90 cm wide. An 113 cm wide corridor leads into the room. Access to the balcony is only possible via two steps.

Bar

The bar is 2 m high and is located in a 2 m wide corridor.

Seating

There is generally no seating available.

Toilets

The toilets are small and can only be accessed via a narrow 2 m corridor. The doors to the toilets are 85 cm wide. The sinks are 95 cm high. There is one toilet with a bowl, labeled TINFA* WC, and one toilet with urinals only, labeled MännerWC. There are no grab rails, menstrual products, or baby changing tables.

Sensory stimuli/atmosphere

The room has no windows but is artificially lit.

KINO

(CINEMA)

Accessibility

Only a small number of seats are raised and accessible via steps; the rest are at ground level. There is sufficient space next to the front rows of seats for wheelchair users to watch the film. The narrowest points of the aisles to the left and right of the cinema seats are approximately 80 cm wide. The floor is paved with cobblestones.

Bar/counter

The bar is 1.23 m high. There are five bar stools.

Seating

There are approximately 80 seats. Cinema seats and sofas at the front (1.8 m wide). During screenings, the light tube is switched on so that the edges of the rows of seats are visible.

Toilets

The toilet is located in another room. It is a gender-neutral cubicle; the key is available at the bar.

Toilet door

80 cm wide, sink: 93 cm high, passageway: 98 cm narrow. There is a shower with a 24 cm step. There are no grab rails, menstrual products, or baby changing table.

Sensory stimuli/atmosphere

Dimmed lighting during screenings. The room is rather cold and has no windows.

Other

There are several pillars in the room that people could potentially bump into.

VORPLATZ (FORECOURT)

Accessibility

The forecourt is wheelchair accessible from the train station. There are also two disabled parking spaces on Schützenmatte.

Seating

There are benches, stones, and steps to sit on.

Toilets

There is a urinal and small cubicles for urinating. The cubicles are labeled “Frauen*-Pissoir” (women’s urinal). There are no grab rails, menstrual products, or baby changing tables.

Sensory stimuli / atmosphere

The square is noisy (train tracks, roads, lots of people). At night, the square under the bridge is lit by lamps. It is sheltered from the rain under the bridge.

Special features/notes

There are sometimes broken glass or syringes on the ground. There are occasional problems with theft, violence, and assaults. For this reason, there are often contact persons with flashing hearts on their jackets on the forecourt, as well as security guards and a security vehicle on the Schützenmatte.

INNENHOF (COURTYARD)

Accessibility

The courtyard is accessible via the large entrance gate (several meters wide) between the forecourt and the courtyard. The floor is paved with cobblestones and is quite uneven. The courtyard is only partially protected from rain.

Seating

There are usually tables and chairs.

Sensory stimuli/atmosphere

It is often noisy, with lots of people and impressions.

TOJO THEATER

Accessibility

The Tojo Theater is at ground level and fully wheelchair accessible for visitors. The floor in the room is made of poured concrete. The backstage area is only accessible via stairs; the area behind the bar is not wheelchair accessible.

Bar

The bar is high and not wheelchair accessible.

Seating

Plenty of seating available (chairs, no sofas or wide seats).

Toilets

There is a barrier-free toilet with a grab rail. Menstrual products are available in the toilets, but there is no baby changing table. The toilets are not divided by gender. Signs indicate where the toilets and urinals are located.

INFOLADEN

Accessibility

There is a 4 cm step at the door, which is approx. 85 cm wide.

Bar/counter

No bar available.

Seating

There is a table that is wheelchair accessible at the short ends. There is a kitchen (94 cm high) and a table with information material (70 cm high). Shelves of varying heights with books and a step stool.

Toilets

No separate toilet available; the toilet in another room must be used.

Sensory stimuli / atmosphere

Many books and posters; the room is rather full and has many visual stimuli. The room has windows and many lamps and pleasant lighting. The room is rather cold.

QUEERFEMINISTISCHER RAUM

Accessibility

The room is accessible to wheelchair users, but is not completely barrier-free. Access is via cobblestones and a stair lift (load capacity 250 kg), which can only be used with assistance from the team (not with a Eurokey). There is a threshold at the entrance, where a small ramp can be installed.

The stage is raised and can be reached via a mobile ramp (85 cm wide, 22% incline). The evacuation route is not wheelchair accessible; there is no fire-safe room.

Bar / Counter

The bar is 117 cm high, with no recessed access at seat height, but it is open at the sides and can be used at a lower height.

Seating

There are several bar stools and many different sofas.

Toilets

The wheelchair-accessible toilet is small (160 × 125 cm), with a door width of 80 cm. There is a folding support handle on the left. The bolt for locking the cubicle requires fine motor skills to operate. Menstrual products are available. There is no baby changing table, but there is a low chest of drawers that can be used as a baby changing table. Changing is permitted anywhere in the room.

Sensory stimuli/atmosphere

The room has many windows and is well lit.

Payment by cash only. No obligation to purchase.
